

**ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY ORDERS FROM  
JACK SMILEY, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALTUS, OKLAHOMA**

**WHEREAS**, prior emergency orders and recommendations have been issued by the Altus Mayor under Chapter 9, Article II, §9-26 through §9-35 of the Altus Municipal Code and the Altus City Council has extended the emergency period and emergency orders until April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. for further consideration and possible action;

**WHEREAS**, the initial emergency orders and recommendations issued on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020, were replaced by emergency orders and recommendations issued on March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the emergency orders and recommendations issued on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020, are still in full force and effect; however, changing circumstances indicate that additional precautionary measures need to be taken;


**NOW THEREFORE**, Jack Smiley, the Mayor of Altus, Oklahoma issues the following additional emergency orders.

**ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY ORDERS**


**The following are orders and must be followed. Violation of these orders is a misdemeanor under Altus Municipal Code Section 9-34. These Orders are in addition to prior, effective emergency orders. The previously issued emergency orders and recommendations remain in full force and effect.**

1. All gymnasiums and fitness centers of all types are closed effective immediately and until further orders.
2. All bowling alleys are closed effective immediately and until further orders.
3. All businesses must make available to customers hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes at each entrance to the business establishment.
4. All businesses must sanitize areas frequently used by customers at least twice per hour. Examples include, but are not limited to, points-of-sale, shopping carts, common-use countertops, main entryway doors and door handles, gas pump handles and keypads computer screens for consumer transactions.
5. Self-service areas for food and beverage must be ceased and terminated effective immediately


