ORDER RESTORING REGULAR JUDICIAL PROCEDURES AND PROCESSES IN THE
ALTUS MUNICIPAL COURT


NOW, on this the 3rd day of February, 2021, the prior JUDICIAL ORDER FOR TRAFFIC CITATIONS NOT PUNISHABLE BY JAIL came on for further review by this Court. This Court finds and orders as follows.

1. The prior JUDICIAL ORDER FOR TRAFFIC CITATIONS NOT PUNISHABLE BY JAIL are no longer necessary and should be vacated and held for naught.
2. Normal court procedures and processes should be reinstated, restored and resumed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS ...

3. This Order shall become effective on the 1 day of March, 2021, at 12:00 o'clock a.m. at which time the prior JUDICIAL ORDER FOR TRAFFIC CITATIONS NOT PUNISHABLE BY JAIL is vacated and held for naught.
4. On the effective date of this order normal process and procedures of the Altus Municipal Court shall be restored, including without limitation, the following.
 - 4.01. All traffic violations, and violations of Altus Municipal Code (AMC), that do not carry the penalty of any term of incarceration (jail) shall not be dismissed with prejudice by the Court, unless this Court enters specific orders in a particular case as it deems warranted.
 - 4.02. Convictions shall be reported unless this Court enters specific orders in a particular case as it deems warranted.
 - 4.03. Individuals charged with a violation must appear in Court in person unless proper arrangements have been made through the Altus Municipal Court Clerk or this Court has entered specific orders in a particular case as it deems warranted.
